What is the Early Career Investigator Award?

The early career investigator award is intended to support clinicians and basic scientists early in their careers in endocrinology to present their original work on adrenal research at ESPE or ECE. The award will cover the cost of preparing a poster (if applicable), as well as travel to the meeting and delegate registration. The next deadline is 10 February 2025.

Who is eligible?

- · Those who work in Germany, Austria, Italy or the UK
- Basic scientists no more than 8 years since completing PhD
- Doctors yet to complete their specialist training
- Nurses and pharmacists with no more than 10 years experience in paediatric endocrinology or endocrinology
- Abstract in the field of adrenal research of any cause

How are abstracts judged?

Abstracts are judged by an independent panel of endocrinologists on novelty, contribution to scientific development, and potential to influence practice.
